Dear ~~Doctor~~ Wright,

Thank you for seeing my patient. She has been diagnosed with a multinodular goiter. I would kindly request you to reassess her and give your expert opinion as she might require a surgical intervention.

Initially, she was presented to me on 12 May 2021, with the chief complaint of fever, sore throat and malaise. She was afebrile and also reported that she returned from a trip few days ago. She was advised to rest and to drink plenty of fluids. On her next follow up she stated, she had a neck swelling since two months which was of olive sized and not painful. On her neck examination there was a swelling about 2x2 cm which moves with deglutition with no palpable lymph nodes. Her vitals and other examination were unremarkable. TFT and US neck were ordered and ^{she was} asked to follow up after 2 weeks.

She has a medical history of asthma and uses Ventolin inhaler. She reported she had an appendectomy when she was 15 and ~~also gives~~ ^{has a} family history of MI and colon cancer. There is no known history of drug allergies. No history of other medications reported.

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On followup with her US and TFT reports after two weeks there was no change in her thyroid exam. TFT was normal and her US neck revealed multiple nodules, calcification on both lobes of thyroid. Based on her examinations and report multinodular goiter was diagnosed and advised her to get a surgical review to rule out the malignancy. However, she was reluctant and asked some time for about a week to think.

Today, the 6th of Oct 2021 she presented with the increase in swelling size with difficulty in swallowing and hoarseness of voice. Since she missed her appointment previously she's worried and accepts surgical intervention if needed.

As the thyroid swelling is increasing in size with enlarged lymph nodes on right side I am worried as she may require an emergency intervention. I would kindly request you to reassess her and give your expert opinion if the surgical intervention is required.
