Mrs Marjorie was diagnosed as Reactive Depression following ^{the} death of older sister. Her symptoms progressed to Depressive psychosis in two months with ~~refusing~~ ^{to} intake ~~of~~ food, and muttering to herself.

Mrs Marjorie, a ~~40 year old patient~~ with family history of depressive illness in ^{her} mother, presented to my OPD on 13/01/10 with poor sleep, lack of energy and loss of weight. Her older sister had died six weeks back because of ^a heart attack. She was diagnosed as Reactive depression and planned for Bereavement counselling with ^a local social worker.
