I am writing to discharge Ms Bell, who was diagnosed with Unstable diabetes mellitus and requires further assessment and management.

Care and support.

Ms Bell was first admitted on 15/06/2017 with complaints of small infected ulcer on her left leg. Her dressing was done with saline. There was no signs of complications. She has been diagnosed with non-insulin-dependent diabetes mellitus 15 years ago. She was commenced on 5mg daily, Metformin 850mg three times a day and amoxicillin 875/125mg orally twice a day. She has to continue her hypoglycaemic agent as well as antibiotic for ulcer. However she has periodic problems with the self-administration of her medicines.
