Thank you for seeing Marjorie Jackson, 40 years old patient, who is diagnosed as depressive psychosis. As per our conversation ~~at~~ <sup>over</sup> telephone, I am writing to refer Mrs Jackson for urgent admission at your hospital for further assessment and management.

Mrs Jackson was brought in by family on 16/3/10 with very withdrawn behaviour of not answering to most questions. She was not taking food and medications for few days as well as making senseless sound. She had mild dehydration. She was diagnosed as depressive psychosis and planned for urgent admission.

Initially, she presented on 13/1/10 with complaint of poor sleep, no energy and loss of weight over several months. She was tearful and depressed. After <sup>the</sup> death of her older sister, she was assessed as reactive depression for which bereavement counselling was given.

On second visit on 22/2/10, she was still tearful with difficulty engaging in normal daily activities and increasingly withdrawn. Doxepin 25mg nocte increasing to 100mg nocte over next 10 days were initiated along with counselling.

In family history, her mother had depressive illness. She had  
past history of post natal depression.

It would be much appreciated if you could further  
assess and manage her accordingly.
