This letter is to discharge Mr. Samuel, under your care for continued dietary compliance and initiation of visits with drug and alcohol counsellor. He was admitted four days back for hypoglycemic episode.

Mr. Samuel presented with Hypoglycemic episode (blood sugar - 2mmol/l) along with 12 sutures to laceration behind left ear and a GCS of 13 (possible concussion).

Mr. Samuel has type I diabetes and relies mostly on takeaway food. He has history of non-compliance with dietary regime and is a heavy drinker.

During the hospital stay, his blood sugar levels were monitored 6 hourly and insulin was administered accordingly. Diet regime has been commenced with dietician and diabetes education with educator. As his GCS was 13 on admission, neurological observations were done 2 hourly.

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Wound management included ice packs to reduce swelling.

Mr. Samuel has sound knowledge of his condition and insulin therapy. The dietary compliance in hospital is good. However, the skin at injection site is in good condition. The wound is dry for now.

Kindly ensure continued dietary compliance and initiate visits with drug and alcohol counsellors. Mr. Samuel's sutures are to be removed in 1 week.
