Thank you for urgently seeing Mrs Hughes, who has a likely diagnosis  
of unstable angina, requiring hospital admission, for urgent assessment  
and further management. ✓ 3/3

Mrs Hughes first presented on 20/09/17 with complaints of 8 episodes  
of central chest pain on exertion, lasting less than 15 minutes within  
the past week. Pain was associated with dyspnoea, radiating down  
left arm and was relieved by rest. However, she has no history of  
palpitations, orthopnoea, and paroxysmal nocturnal dyspnoea.

Examination findings were normal with normal Electrocardiogram

Please note, the patient is anxious and believes she had a  
heart attack, as her maternal grandmother had also suffered  
from acute myocardial infarction at age of 57 years and died of  
ischemic stroke at the age of 59 years.

Mrs. Hughes is a retired office clerk, living with her husband. She  
doesn't smoke and drinks socially.

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In the past, she suffered from Acute dehydration and Addison's disease in 2004 and was diagnosed with hypertension in 2006.

She is currently under corticosteroids.
